Notice of Pre-Hearing Conference and Intervention Deadline

On January 30, 2026, NextEra Energy Transmission MidAtlantic, Inc. (“NEET MA”) filed with the Maryland Public Service Commission an Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) to construct the Maryland portion (approximately 35.4 miles of new 500 kV transmission line and related facilities) of the MidAtlantic Resiliency Link Project (“MARL”) located in Allegany and Garrett Counties, Maryland. The Application and other pleadings in the matter may be viewed or downloaded from the Maryland Public Service Commission’s website, <https://www.psc.state.md.us/>, docketed under Case Number 9857.

A pre-hearing conference in the above-captioned matter is scheduled for **Thursday, April 9, 2026 at 10:00 a.m.**, in the 19th floor hearing room of the Maryland Public Service Commission, William Donald Schaefer Tower, 6 St. Paul Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21202. The purpose of the prehearing conference is to discuss any preliminary matters, including the consideration of any petitions to intervene and the establishment of a procedural schedule.

Any persons seeking to intervene in this proceeding must file a petition to intervene by **April 3, 2026**. Petitions to intervene may be filed electronically through the Commission’s website at www.psc.state.md.us or sent by first-class mail to the Commission’s Executive Secretary, Andrew S. Johnston, 6 St. Paul Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21202-6806, and must reference “Case No. 9857.”¹
